Two errors were identified in the original 2024 printing of the *Indicators of Higher Education Equity in the United States: 2024 50-Year Historical Trend Report* during the update for the new edition. These errors were corrected in the electronic version of the publication:

- In Indicator 7d(iii) on page 287 and Indicator 7d(iv) on page 288, the scale on the y-axis did not correspond to the estimates in the line graph. The scales were corrected to match the figure's data labels, which were verified to be accurate.
- In Indicator 7d(vi) on page 292 and the corresponding text on page 291, the estimate of 71% was mistakenly reported for the percentage of McNair students moving on to graduate school after graduation. This percentage was the goal mentioned in the report used as the source for this finding. The actual percentage was 64%. Corrections were made to the figure and the text. We also updated the change statistic from 69% to 53%. The chapter summary accurately cited the U.S. Department of Education report.
